



## All-Hazards Position Specific Training

### *For All First Responders*

NERAC is sponsoring six (6) NIMS ICS All-Hazards Position Specific Training courses for all first responders from the NERAC region. These courses are designed by the Emergency Management Institute (EMI) and will be conducted by the Incident Management Training Consortium (IMTC) on the dates and locations below.

All first responders from the NERAC region are eligible to attend these courses, however **priority seating will be given to individuals who would be likely to fill a leadership position in an ICS structure at a major incident.**

**Backfill/overtime will be offered at up to \$35/hour and lunch will be provided each day.**

All attendees must have completed ICS-300, and completion of ICS-400 is preferred.
