LDH 1: Hydrant with steamer available Performance / Task description

- 1. Remove 4-inch supply line from bed of truck.
- 2. Remove Hydrassist Valve and Hydrant Bag from compartment
- 3. Bring proper tools ie... radio, hydrant wrench, two spanners
- 4. Wrap hydrant properly by creating an "X" around the backside of the hydrant leaving sufficient amount of hose to make connection.
- 5. Signal vehicle operator move forward while standing on hose at the "X".
- 6. When appropriate, unwrap hose from the hydrant.
- 7. Loosen Steamer cap and 2 ½ inch caps then place hydrant wrench on stem.
- 8. Remove caps and place them at rear of hydrant.
- Attach Hydrassist Valve to hydrant with the handle toward outlet "B" labeled "TO FIRE"
- 10. Attach Morse gates in the closed position.
- 11. Attach 4-inch supply line to Hydrassist valve outlet "B" labeled "TO FIRE".
- 12. Request permission to charge hydrant.
- 13. Open hydrant fully and correctly.
- 14. Retrieve tools and rejoin crew; checking couplings along the way.
