LDH2: Hydrant with No Steamer Available Performance / Task description

- 1. Remove 4-inch supply line from bed of truck.
- 2. Remove Hydrassist Valve and Hydrant Bag from compartment.
- 3. Bring proper tools ie... radio, hydrant wrench, two spanners.
- 4. Wrap hydrant properly by creating an "X" around the backside of the hydrant leaving sufficient amount of hose to make connection.
- 5. Signal vehicle operator to move forward while standing on hose at the "X".
- 6. When appropriate unwrap hose.
- 7. Loosen 2 ½ inch caps then place hydrant wrench on stem.
- 8. Remove caps and place them at rear of hydrant.
- 9. Attach two Morse gates to hydrant in the open position.
- 10. Attach two "short" 3 inch supply lines to Morse gates.
- 11. Attach 4-inch storz to 41/2 in threaded adapter to Hydrassist valve inlet "A" labeled "WATER"
- 12. Attach Siamese to Hydrassist valve outlet "B" labeled "TO FIRE".
- 13. Attach the two "short" 3 inch feeder hoses from the Morse gates to the Siamese
- 14. Attach 4-inch supply line to Hydrassist valve outlet "B" labeled "TO FIRE".
- 15. Position handle on Hydrassist valve toward out "B" labeled "TO FIRE".
- 16. Request permission to charge hydrant.
- 17. Open hydrant fully and correctly.
- 18. Retrieve tools and rejoin crew; checking couplings along the way.
