LDH 3: Establishing a Water Supply to the Working Engine Company Performance / Task description

1. Choose the most appropriate hydrant to the incident.
2. Drop off the Hydrant-man and await the signal before moving forward.
3. Position apparatus
4. Engage parking brake prior to exiting the apparatus.
5. Chock the tires immediately after exiting the apparatus.
6. Remove the appropriate amount of (LDH) inch supply line from truck.
7. Attach the (LDH) supply line to the LDH intake of the working pump.
8. Confirm (LDH) intake valve is closed with the bleeder open.
9. Communicate with the hydrant-man to charge the supply line.
10. After all air has escaped from the bleeder close the bleeder.
11. Open the (LDH) intake.
12. Notify driver/operator of working engine that he/she has water.
13. Check lines for kinks, loose couplings etc.
